# STATEMENT OF BELIEFS

1. We believe in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments as the verbally inspired Word of God, completely inerrant in the original writings and of supreme and final authority for faith and life.
2. We believe in one God, eternally existing in three persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit .
3. We believe that Jesus Christ was begotten of the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary and is true God and true man.
4. We believe that man was created in the image of God; that he sinned and thereby incurred not only physical death but also spiritual death which is separation from God; and that all human beings are born with a sinful nature and in the case of those who reach moral responsibility, become sinners in thought, word, and deed.
5. We believe that the Lord Jesus Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures as a representative and substitutionary sacrifice, and that all who believe and trust in Him are justified on the ground of His shed blood.
6. We believe in the bodily resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ; in His ascension into Heaven, and His present life for us as High Priest and Advocate.
7. We believe in "that blessed hope", the personal, premillennial return of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.
8. We believe that all who receive by faith the Lord Jesus Christ are born of the Holy Spirit and thereby become children of God, a relationship in which they are eternally secure.
9. We believe in the bodily resurrection of the just and the unjust; the everlasting blessedness of the saved and the everlasting conscious punishment of the lost.
10. We believe that the Holy Spirit is a person possessing all the attributes of God. He convicts the world of sin, righteousness and judgment; He is the supernatural Agent in regeneration, baptizing all believers into the body of Christ, indwelling and sealing them unto the day of redemption.
11. We believe that the Holy Spirit sovereignly bestows spiritual gifts as He sees fit and therefore, we do not promote the seeking or the practice of miraculous sign gifts such as speaking in tongues, healing, or the working of miracles which were designated in the New Testament as signs verifying the ministry of the Apostles.
12. We believe that marriage is a covenant between one man and one woman before God for life.
13. We believe sexual activity is designed by God to be expressed within a covenant marriage relationship between one man and one woman before God for life. All sexual activity outside of this covenant marriage relationship is forbidden by God through the whole of Scripture, both Old and New Testaments.
14. We believe that each individual's sexual orientation/identity is designed by God to be male or female.
15. We believe the Camp's land and physical facilities are a gift from God and that we are to use them in ways that honor the Lord and are consistent with the Bible and our Purpose Statement and Statement of Beliefs.

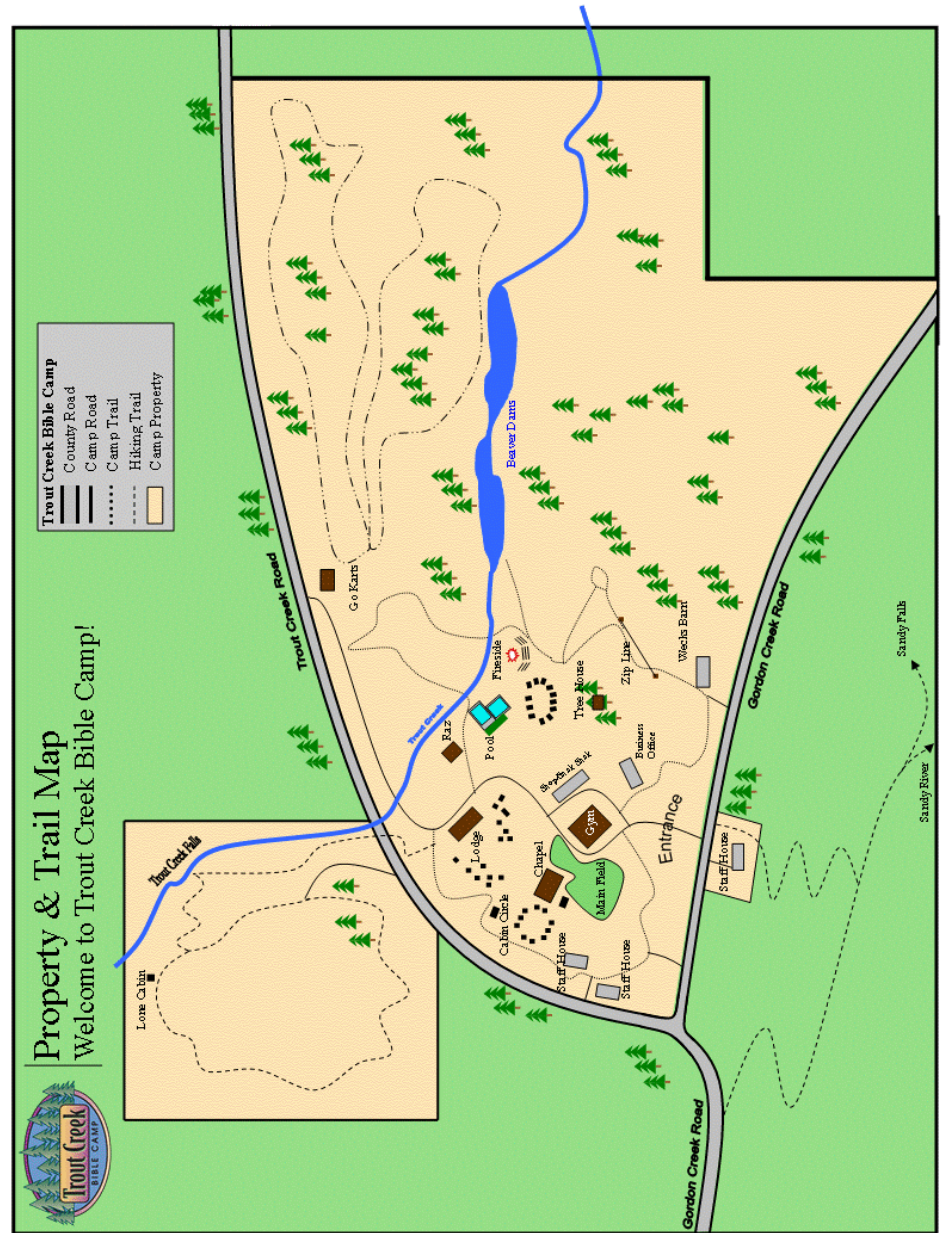
Our desire is to partner with your ministry. The camp setting is a powerful resource, and we stand ready to serve you so that your group can have a memorable experience.

Come out and enjoy the scenery, a wide variety of recreational activities, and excellent food service.

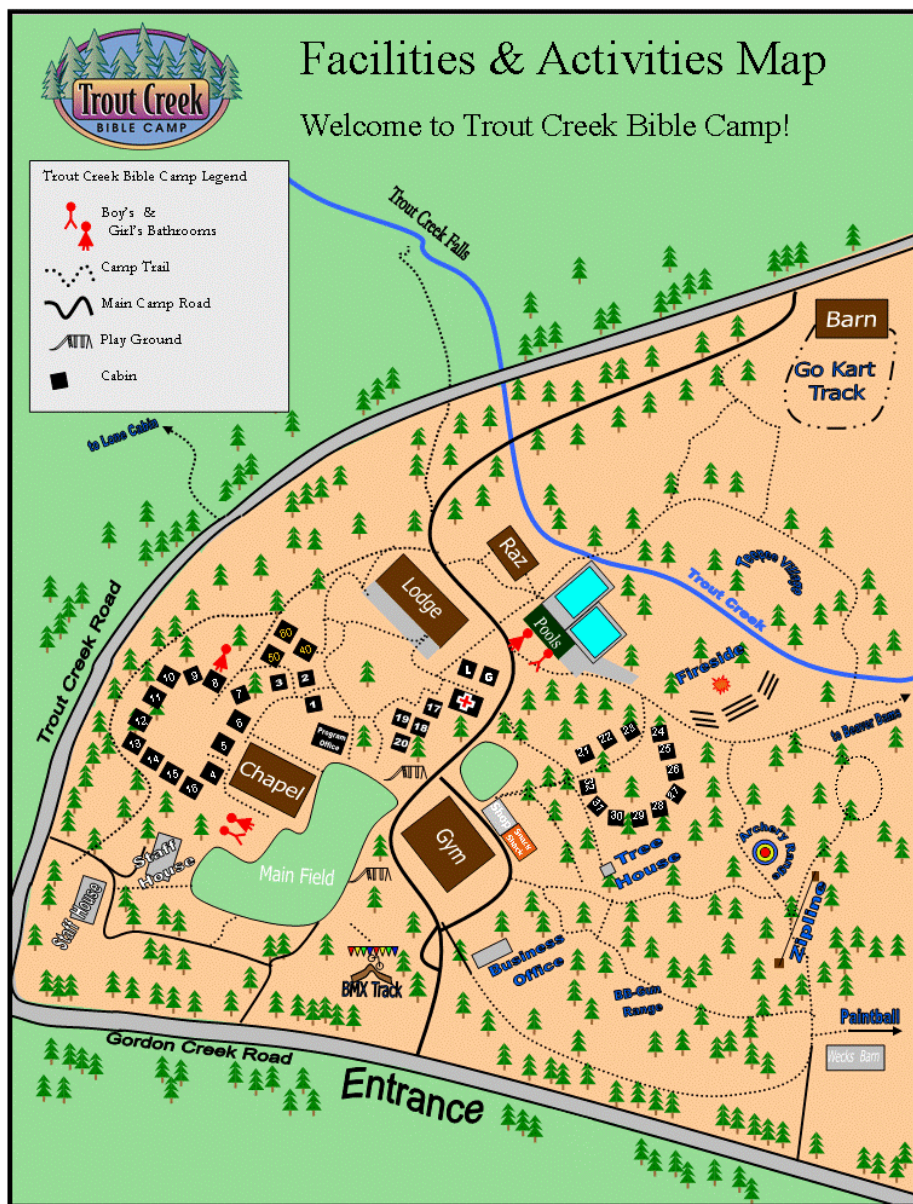

# CHAPEL



The chapel has a seating capacity of 400 people. The large, raised stage is perfect for skits, a speaker or a worship band. We also provide a sound system and video projection for your use.



There are four break-out rooms behind the main chapel that are great for smaller group meetings or a more intimate atmosphere.



# GYM

The gym is a large structure that allows great recreation options even in the rain. It has an asphalt floor and a full-size basketball court, as well as side-court baskets. The floor can also be set up for volleyball. The gym is the home of a five level climbing wall, carpet ball, game room, and a Pepsi machine.



# GAME ROOM

Above the gym lobby, the game room is a great place to hang out and play games. The activities include foosball, ping pong, air-hockey, and billiards.

# PLAYING FIELD

The playing field is located near the gym and the chapel. It is a great space for group games and outdoor activities or just hanging out.



# THE RAZ

The Raz is a place to hang out and watch the creek as the water drifts by. This covered area is a great location for outdoor small group meetings, fellowshiping, or just relaxing to the sound of the creek.

# OPTIONAL ACTIVITIES

## ZIP LINE TOUR

The zip line is a fun activity for those 12-years-old and above. Campers are harnessed in and “fly” down two different cables for an exhilarating ride.



## CLIMBING WALL

The climbing wall is a great challenge for both young and old. All climbers are harnessed in and supervised by trained personnel. It is a great opportunity to test one’s courage and ability.

## PAINTBALL

Our paintball course is a great place to enjoy this popular activity. We provide all the equipment you need for fun and safety.



## POOLS

We offer two pools, available from Memorial Day to Labor Day. The game pool is a shallower pool, ranging from 3’ to 5’ and is great for splashing around. The deeper dive pool includes a 46 ft. water slide, diving board, and a basketball hoop.

## ARCHERY

Our archery range is a fun place to experience the “old west”. We provide the arrows, bows, and targets—you provide the strength and aim.

# ACTIVITIES



## SWINGS

The swings are a favorite of most kids. Climbing up on to the platform you can launch yourself off in one of two swings. While waiting in line, you may also enjoy sliding and playing.

## DISC GOLF

Trout Creek's nine hole disc golf course is a fun way to hike around camp. Each hole poses different challenges as you try to stay below par.



## GAGA BALL

Gaga Ball is one of our more popular activities. It is a game that all ages can play, from children to adults. This is a great activity that has been a hit with our campers and guests.



## THE CREEK

Whether you just want to watch the creek, dangle your legs over it while sitting on a bridge, walk in it, or try to catch crawdads or trout, the creek is a great place to hang out.



## HIKING

While living in the hustle and bustle of the city, it is hard to find time to really appreciate the beauty of God's creation. Hiking on one of our many trails is a great way to see the beauty and great scenery around camp. There are many places to explore such as the Beaver Dams, the Trout Creek Falls, the Bluff Loop, the Sandy River, and more.



## POOL PATIO

The pool patio is a great place to be on warm spring and fall days. The patio overlooks the pool area and is great for sitting for with friends to enjoy the day.



## FIRESIDE

As the day turns to dusk and the sun begins to set, fireside is a great place to end the day with skits, songs, and a time of fun and reflection. This outdoor area can seat up to 300 on benches arranged in amphitheater-style facing the fire pit.

## TREE HOUSE

Nestled in the boughs of old-growth fir, the tree house is a 2-story structure with a winding staircase leading to the front door. On the lower level, you will find a sitting area. A staircase leads to the upper, sleeping level.



## BATHROOMS

Located in strategic areas throughout the camp, the separate bathroom facilities include showers and dressing areas. The bathrooms are clean, heated, and have tile floors for comfortable use.

# HOUSING INFORMATION

## CABINS

Recently built, these beautiful cabins are the mainstay for retreat housing. The cabins are conveniently arranged in two circles on separate sides of the camp, one with 13 cabins each having a capacity of 15 people, the other with 12 cabins each having a capacity of 14 people.



These cabins feature open beam construction and gable windows, gas heat, comfy bunks, and covered porches.

They offer a very inviting, comfortable atmosphere for sleeping and just hanging out.

## NURSE'S CABIN

With its own bathroom, the nurse's cabin is a great spot for speakers or leaders. The nurse's cabin features a bedroom with a queen-sized bed, a bathroom, and a front room that has a futon bunk bed. This cabin also has a fridge and microwave for late night snack needs.



## GUEST CABIN

The Guest Cabin is great for speakers and special guests. This cabin has a small living room with a sleeper sofa, a bathroom, and a bedroom with a king-sized bed. It is carpeted and has a homey feel to it.



## UPPER LODGE

Above the lodge, there are six rooms and a central bathroom to accommodate guests. Four of the rooms have two queen-sized beds, the other rooms have one queen-sized bed each. This is a great place for staff, or adults who would prefer a little more privacy.
