MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Good character, integrity, and adaptability

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- To assist the counselor in identifying and meeting camper needs, in accordance with the purpose of Trout Creek Bible Camp.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Assist the Counselor and take part in all camper related activities
2. Be familiar with the camp grounds and facilities
3. To operate or assist in operating different program functions such as: climbing wall, swimming pool, zip line, paintball etc.
4. Assist in the teaching of an Activity or Club
5. Participate in a daily CIT Bible study
6. Work with Counselors to help supervise campers during daily Cabin Clean – Up
