GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

 To Oversee and run the Go Kart program in accordance with the purpose of Trout Creek Bible Camp

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Oversee the daily care and prep of go karts
- Do basic maintenance on all go karts and keep record of what is done
- Communicate with Program Director & Facilities Manager about maintenance issues.
- Assist with the daily care and prep of go karts
- Do basic maintenance on all go karts
- Communicate with Lead about maintenance issues
- Work with the go karts prior to camper use
- Maintain the track and surrounding facility
- Stress safety at all times to staff and campers
- Do everything that is asked of you by the Program Director & Facilities Manager.
- Develop and lead Go Kart Klub (teach, model, lead prayer, etc.)
- Attend designated staff Bible studies and meetings
- Take part in other program activities (fireside, skits, etc.)
- Follow all staff rules and regulations (The Law/Child Protection Plan/Social Media Policy)
