GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

To supervise, and encourage CIT's in their responsibilities, in conjunction with the Counselor Deans, in accordance with the purpose of Trout Creek Bible Camp.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist in teaching CIT's their responsibilities during staff training.
- Supervise CIT's and oversee their performance in accordance with job description.
- Attend and lead a daily CIT Bible study/meeting, and advise, encourage, and pray with/for the
- Spend time with each CIT in your group for encouragement and accountability.
- Assist the L.E.A.D.(s), Director and other Leadership staff in making staff and camper related decisions regarding discipline.
- Formally evaluate CIT's in your group after summer ends.
- Make sure the CIT's are in their cabins at night, make regular rounds through cabin.
- Enforce curfew every night.
- Plan, implement, and attend CIT encouragement times (evening parties, outings, etc.) subject to approval of the L.E.A.D.(s) and Director.
- Score Cabin clean-up and turn scores into Program Director daily.
- Participate in the program schedule and make sure CIT's are interacting with the campers and involved with the program throughout the day.
- Be present at Activity time, handling anything that arises and maintaining order.
- Be present at Cabin clean-up, handling anything that arises and maintaining order.
- Follow & enforce all staff rules and regulations (The Law/Child Protection Plan/Social Media Policy) and work with L.E.A.D.(s) and Camp Director to implement consequences when appropriate.

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SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES (continued)

- Coordinate with Program Director to ensure CIT's are present and dutiful in the execution of their free-time duties (climbing wall, zip-line, etc.)
- Regularly encourage and facilitate a strong devotional life for CIT's in your group
- Work with Counselor Dean, L.E.A.D.(s) and Camp Director to create counselor pairs.
- Weekly, work with Counselor Dean to assemble counselor packets
- Other responsibilities may be assigned as required, and some responsibilities may be reassigned
