GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

 To capture photo memories of the camp experience and utilize those photos on the web, at camp, and as still photos.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work hard at the tasks assigned to you
- Be on time to your specified task
- Follow all staff rules and regulations (The Law/Child Protection Plan/Social Media Policy)
- Participate in a program staff Bible study
- Keep the program office clean
- Get to know the other staff and enjoy fellowship times with them
- Job specific tasks
 - □ Take pictures all times of the day
 - □ Take & edit cabin and all camp photos on the first day of each session
 - Organize pictures for cabin & all camp photos and save on Public Documents so order can be made by Tuesday morning
 - Take pictures of campers and camp activities until you are blue in the face! Or you finish the check list provided by the Program Director
 - Daily upload photos to Facebook (example of Album title: Junior 1 Day 1 2018)
 - Put captured photos into files on external hard drive folders (example of file name: 2018 Junior 1, day 1; Junior 1, day 2, etc)
 - □ Be sure that at the end of each week your photos are on the external hard drive.
- Some of the duties may be reassigned, while others may be assigned as required
- Check the camper list every week on Waldo Photo to know what campers need pictures every day
- Check status of each camper on Waldo Photo during the week to make sure they are getting pictures taken
