



2021 Family Camp Update about Camp & Covid

We are pleased to announce that the state of Oregon has officially given permission for overnight camps to operate this summer!

This means that TCBC will officially be running our full overnight program this year – including Family Camp!

The state has also released new guidelines for running a safe overnight camp. Here are some FAQ's about what you can expect camp to look like this summer:

Will family campers be required to wear face coverings?

- In certain circumstances, family campers will be asked to wear a face covering. These include while participating in indoor activities and when social distancing is not possible.
- Family campers will not be asked to wear a face covering while doing activities that make face coverings unsafe or unfeasible, such as swimming or sleeping.

Are family campers required to get vaccinated?

- No. We encourage families to make their own decisions about vaccinations.
- All family campers, regardless of vaccination status, will be provided access to the full camp program.
- If a family camper is exposed to a confirmed or suspected case of COVID-19, the state will require non-vaccinated campers to quarantine according to health authority guidelines.

Will the pools be open this year?

- Yes! In addition to all our normal camp activities, our pools will be open for use this summer!

Will family campers be able to interact with other family campers?

- Each "family group" will be assigned their own housing prior to arriving at camp.
- In addition, we are permitted to have up to 30 family campers in each stable cohort group. Each family can then choose a "buddy family group" with whom they can do joint activities.

What other COVID-19 precautions do you have in place?

- Along with regular cleaning and sanitizing of shared facilities (multiple times daily), hand sanitizer and handwashing sinks are available throughout the camp.
- Family campers are encouraged to wash and/or sanitize their hands frequently throughout each day.
- We'll also do a fun and thorough first-day orientation to make sure all family campers know how to stay safe and healthy at camp!
